ABOUT GEORGINA

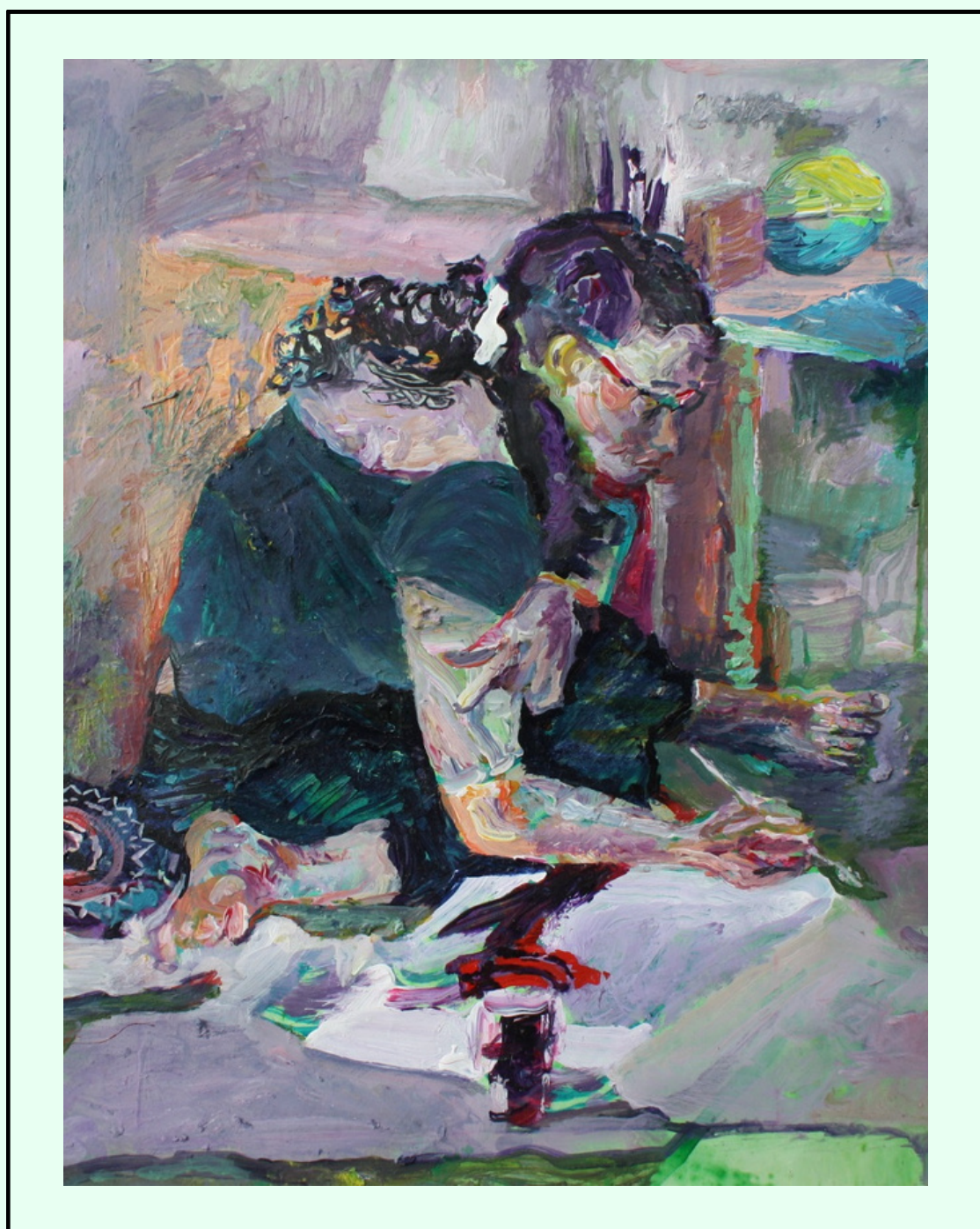

ABOUT KASPER

I'm Kasper, an art historian specialised in contemporary art in the Middle-East and a painter of colourful acrylic works on paper. These two roles complement each other quite well; theoretical reflection informing creative perception and vice versa. However, as an artist I feel I can more freely traverse the personal, poetic and everyday beyond the strictures of academic language. My works show glimpses of my inner world, where obsessive historical ponderings may have marinated for years or, contrarily, where traces of daily encounters may be spontaneously expressed in paint. Over the last three years my painting engages the Islamic faith as an orientation on the world and my moving about in it. Fed up with the mainstream discourse of colliding outward identities, I approach Islam as an inward force and explore how its metaphorical universes cast new lights on the ecstasies and drudgeries of everyday life.

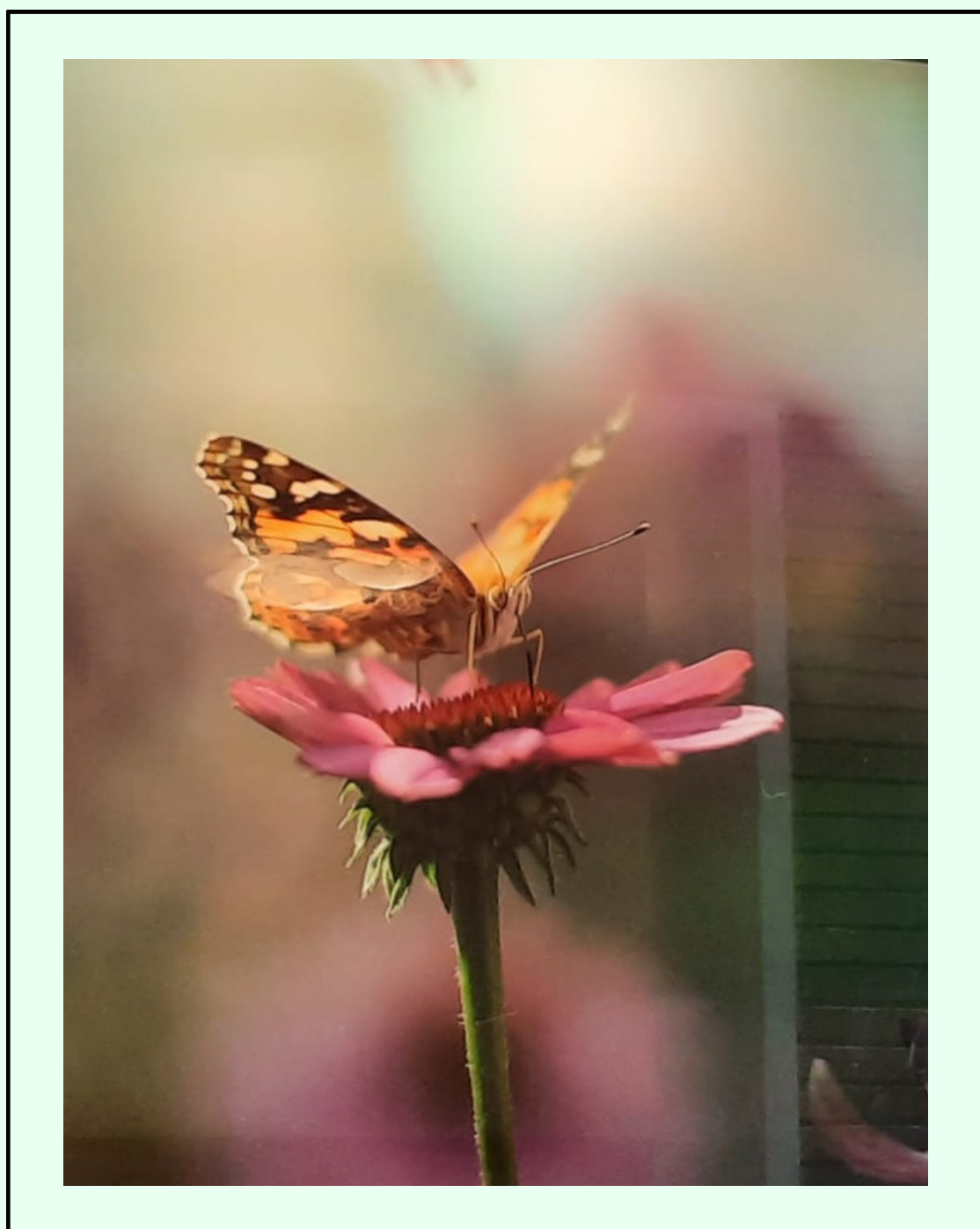
ABOUT ELLIS

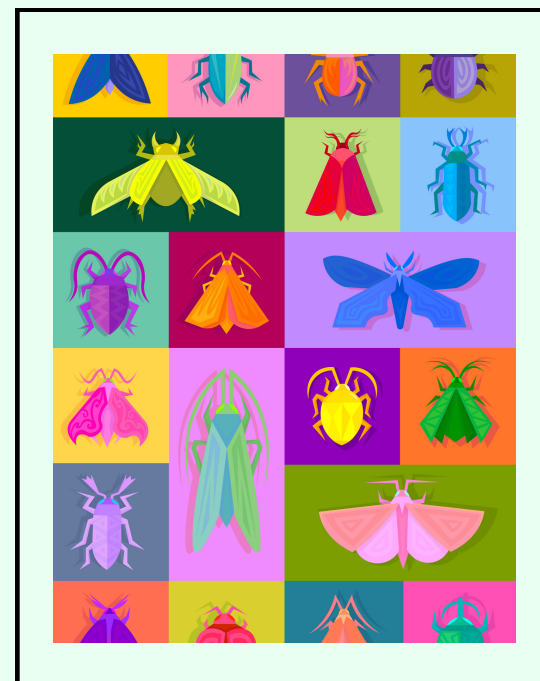

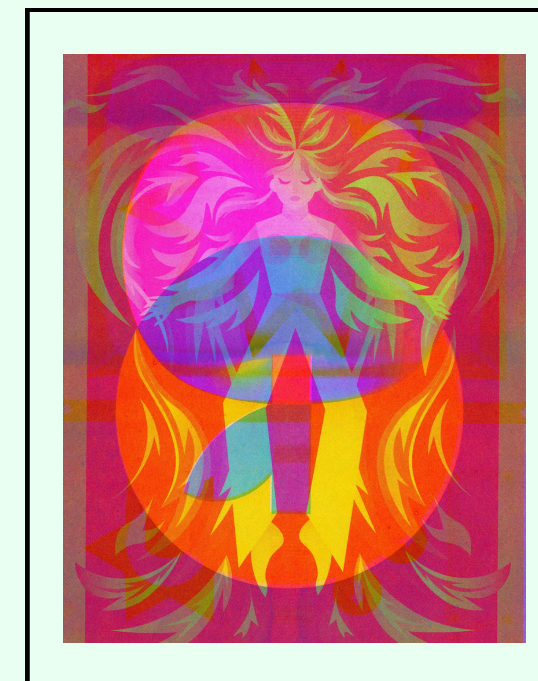
Wide Vijselaar is a photographer based in Leiden. Once a student at Leiden University, he is excited to get to show his works to the students of the university he used to frequent in his student years.

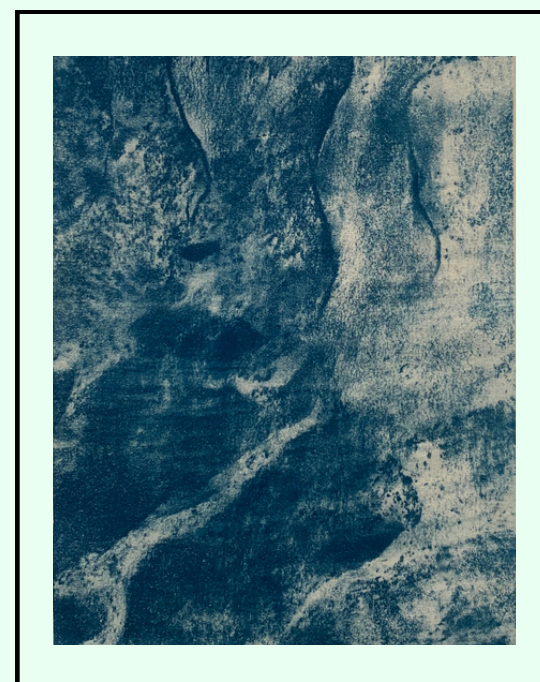

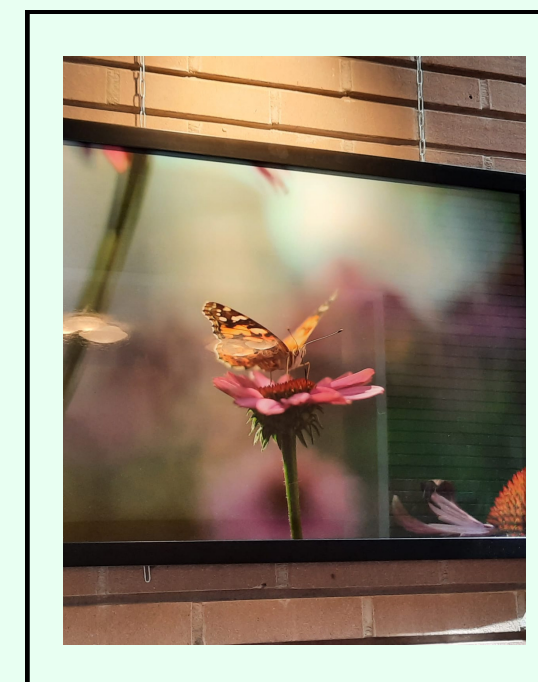

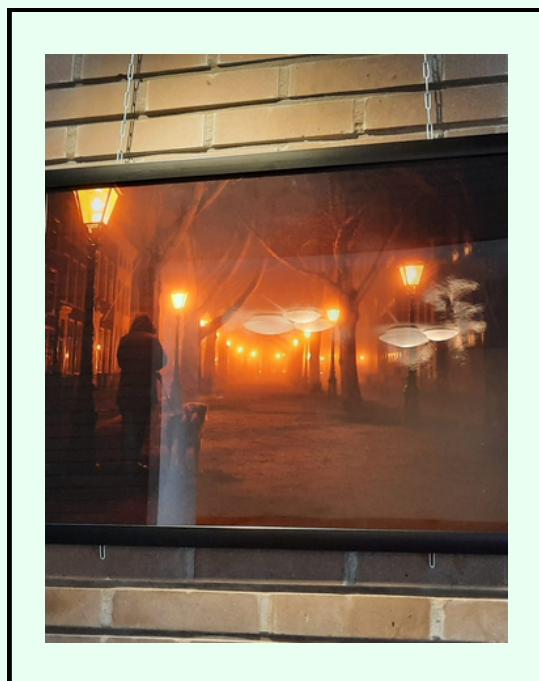

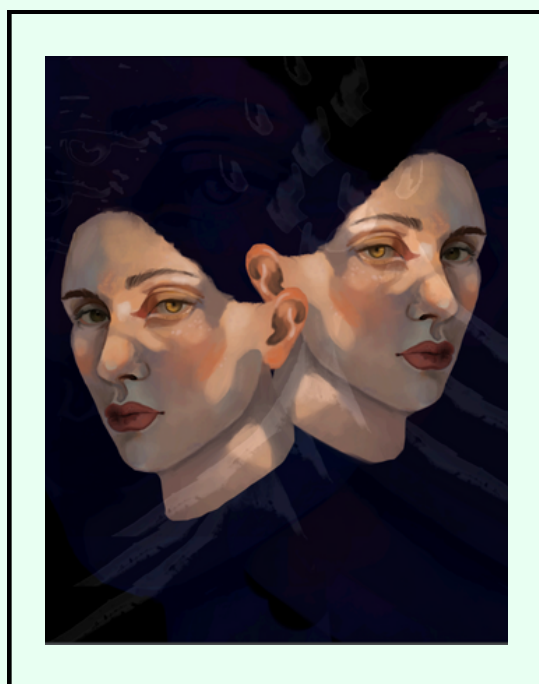

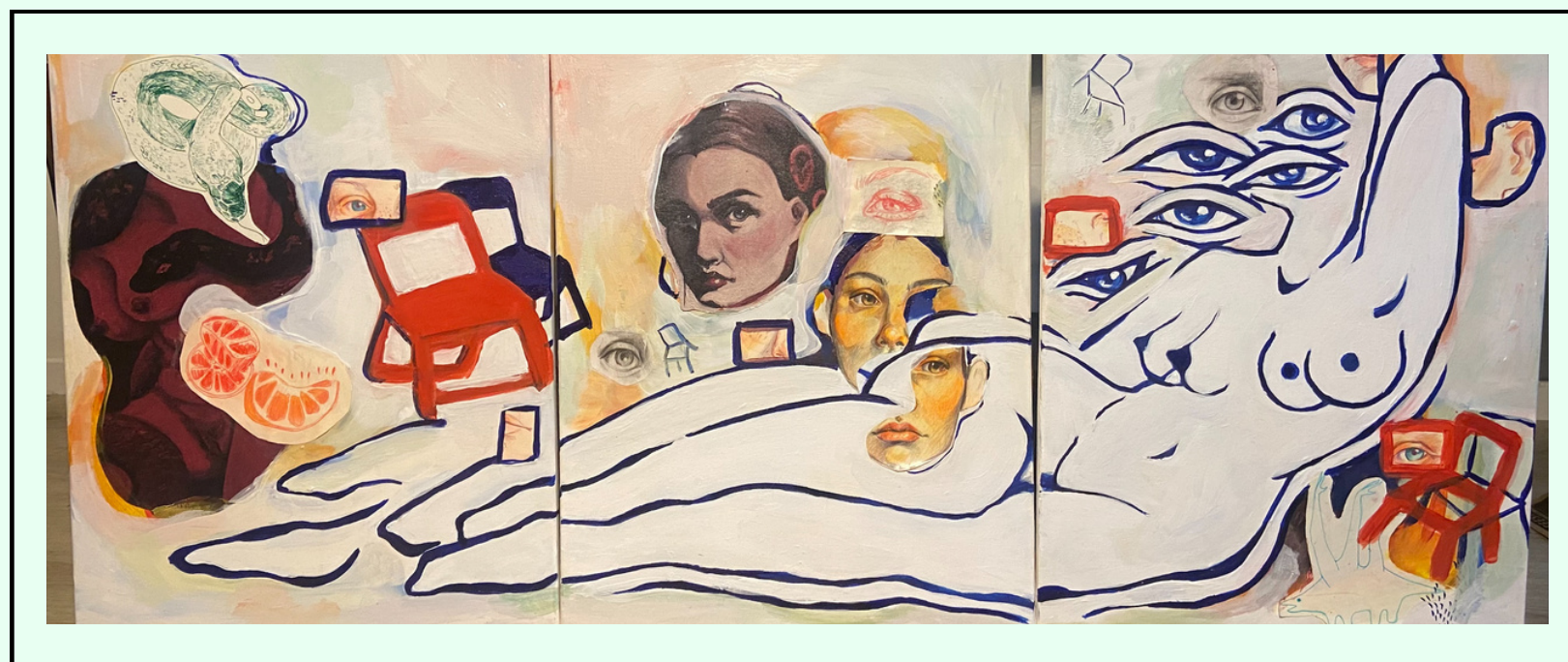
